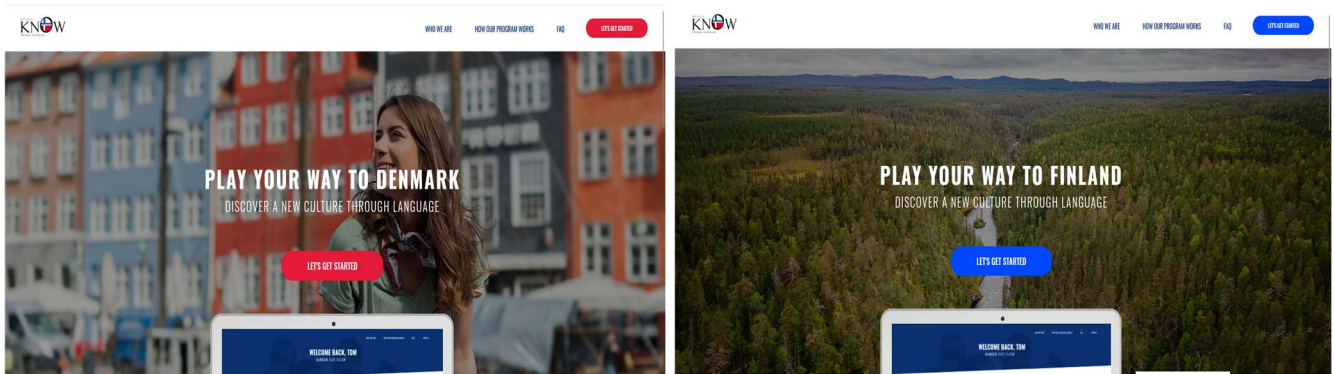

Each platform includes two modules with 10 self-learning lessons - first module focuses on the language, and the second one, on the culture.

The language module focuses on the basic language skills such as listening, speaking, and reading.

Upon successful completion of all lessons of the first module, learners become acquainted with the language at the level equivalent to A1 and receive certificates
